Dear Carpool Participants,

Below you will see a diagram showing the correct carpool procedure. If the line in front of the school is 5 ½ Street is long, please DO NOT park on Linn Street. This blocks incoming traffic to the Community Center and creates a safety hazard. Also, please keep the entrance to the parking lot unblocked. The City of Monticello requests that parents drive into the Community Center parking lot and take a right back onto 5 ½ Street if the line requires you to do so. SRMCS staff work as efficiently as possible to keep the carpool line moving. To help with this process, we encourage each vehicle to place a sign on the passenger side of the front dashboard with the child's last name on it in large print.

Carpool times are as follows:

- Mornings from 8:40 8:50 am
- Afternoons from 3:20 3:35 pm

Please note that school starts promptly at 8:55 am each day. In order for the staff to be in their classrooms to begin the day, carpool doors promptly at 8:50 a.m. Over the years, we have noticed that dropping your child(ren) off at the carpool doors after 8:50 a.m. likely leads to your child(ren) being tardy to class. All tardies due to late drop off are logged and are considered unexcused unless the office receives prior notification. Multiple unexcused tardies will be addressed by the School Director per the SRMCS Attendance Policy. The policy is located on the school's website at www.swanrivermontessori.org for you referenc3e.

It is of utmost importance that all drivers using carpool be courteous of one another, always watch for children, stay in the line, and wait your turn, and pull away from the curb cautiously. Finally, please remember that SRMCS staff cannot buckle your child(ren) for you.
