## SRMCS Re-Enrollment Form for 2023-2024

Dear SRMCS Families,

Now that the new year has begun, SRMCS is beginning to plan for the 2023-2024 school year. Please note that all students currently enrolled are guaranteed placement every year. To help us with enrollment projections, we require that you **complete the re-enrollment form below and return it to our main office by Friday, December 13, 2022.** One form is required per enrolled student.

#### Sibling Enrollment:

If you plan to enroll any siblings at SRMCS, the enrollment form for new students is available on the Swan River web site at <a href="https://www.swanrivermontessori.org/admissions">www.swanrivermontessori.org/admissions</a>. Sibling enrollment forms must be received by Tuesday, December 13, 2022, and listed on the form below. An application must be received for each sibling by this date otherwise they will not be given preference in the lottery. This includes siblings entering the early childhood program.

#### **New Student/Non-Sibling Enrollment:**

Enrollment forms for new students who are NOT siblings of a currently enrolled student will be accepted January 3-13, 2023, in the main office. All available slots will be filled on February 9, 2023 when the lottery is held at SRMCS at 10:00 a.m. New students/non-siblings wishing to enroll in the early childhood program may submit an application upon return from winter break on January 3, 2023. A letter regarding official enrollment status in the early childhood program will be sent within 10 business days following the lottery on February 9<sup>th</sup>.
